

HIGHLAND SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC WALL OF FAME

Highland Springs recognizes the contribution of all its athletes throughout its history. It is the mission of the Athletic Wall of Fame Committee to induct over a period of time all deserving athletes described in the criteria selection. It is not the intent or mission of the Highland Springs Athletic Wall of Fame to determine the best athlete or athletes in a particular sport or in the general athletic history of the school. The order of induction is not an indication of an athlete's value or worth as a player or person.

- I. The Athletic Wall of Fame will be an annual affair sponsored by the athletic department.
- II. The selection of inductees shall be by committee. The Wall of Fame Committee shall be composed of the following:
 - A. Six alumni representatives chosen by the Activities Director and Principal.
 - B. Two Springer coaches with at least ten (10) years of service at Highland Springs High School.
 - C. Two members of the Springer faculty with at least ten (10) years of service at Highland Springs High School.
 - C. One member of the Springer administration with at least ten (10) years of service at Highland Springs High School.
- III. The selection process will be as follows:
 - A. Nominations will be sought through the various news media.
 - B. The selection committee will review the nominees and choose 15 final nominees.
 - C. A prioritized list of a minimum of seven (7) candidates will be submitted to the activities director and administrative staff for final approval of inductees.
 - D. There will be an automatic selection of coaches who coached state championship teams. This is done upon retirement from coaching and is separate and not included with other applications.
- IV. The criteria for nomination will be as follows:
 - A. The nominee must be out of high school for ten (10) years.
